

Post-Dip Solution SLOTOPAS NT 1300

Post-Dip Solution SLOTOPAS NT 1300 is used for post-treatment on already passivated zinc and zinc-nickel alloy layers. Post-Dip Solution SLOTOPAS NT 1300 is applied alternatively to a sealant. It can be used for both rack- and barrel plating

Post-Dip Solution SLOTOPAS NT 1300 produces black passivated layers, less sensitive to touching, abrasion and scratches and ensures the necessary corrosion protection.

Transparent passivated zinc-nickel coatings treated with Post-Dip Solution SLOTOPAS NT 1300 become almost insensitive to fingerprints. This simplifies the handling of the parts enormously.

Post-Dip Solution SLOTOPAS NT 1300 is a purely inorganic post-treatment based on Cr(III) and contains neither Cr(VI) compounds nor cobalt.

The information in this data sheet is based on laboratory as well as practical experience. Figures quoted for operating limits and replenishment quantities are for guidance. Actual values necessary will depend on the components being plated (material and geometry), their application and plating plant conditions.
