

Bright Zinc Bath SLOTOCYN 10

Easy operation, excellent stability and high applicable cathodic current densities are the features of the cyanidic Bright Zinc SLOTOCYN 10. Even at a slightly higher operating temperature the coatings are over a wide current density range bright and have a good passivating behaviour. Depending on the zinc concentration Bright Zinc SLOTOCYN 10 can be operated in both rack- and barrel installations with either high or low cyanide values.

The information in this data sheet is based on laboratory as well as practical experience. Figures quoted for operating limits and replenishment quantities are for guidance only. Actual values necessary will depend on the components being plated (material and geometry), their application and plating plant conditions.
